



## Emergency Checklist for My Pet

While it's not fun to imagine, now is an important time to create a plan for your pet in case you get sick. We strongly encourage you to gather any members of your household and walk through the following steps to ensure your animals will be well cared for in the event of an emergency.

Your kit should include the following, as best as you're able:

- Name and contact information for the person who can care for your pets:

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- Name and contact information for your back-up in case your go-to is no longer able to help:

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- Food, treats, a leash, a couple of toys, and any other supplies necessary to care for your pet for at least two weeks

- A crate or carrier to transport your pet

- Vaccination records (during pandemic, you can request this by email from your vet)

- Collars with ID tags (with up-to-date phone number)

- Make sure your pet's microchip information is up to date
